Spirit Week Festivities

Homecoming Festivities

Homecoming is Friday, October 23. We are playing the Chancellor Chargers, and our theme this year is "Unplug the Chargers!" We will have a Homecoming Court consisting of a Prince and a Princess from the Freshman, Sophomore, and Junior classes as well as a King and Queen from the Senior class. Nominations will take place during the week of **October 5** in first period classes. In order to appear on the ballot, all nominees must have purchased a ticket to the Homecoming dance. Voting will take place in first block classes the following week and winners will be announced during Spirit Week.

The princes and princesses as well as the Homecoming Court (the top eight seniors) will be featured during the halftime program, at Friday night's football game, and our Homecoming King and Queen will be crowned.

Bonfire/Parade info will be coming from Ms. Zellerino. Those details are still a work in progress.

There will be a Homecoming Pep Rally on Friday, October 23. We will be following the Activity Bell Schedule, so class periods are shorter that day. More information will be coming about the Pep Rally as time approaches.

The Dance: Glowcoming 2015

The Homecoming Dance (Glowcoming 2015) will be Saturday, October 24 from 7-10 P.M. This year our dance will feature an exciting glow/light theme. **Teachers who are interested in chaperoning should email Ms. Blackwell or Mrs. Sadler ASAP.** This is a semi-formal event (see below) and it is always nice to see the students dressed up. Tickets will be on sale starting October 1. Tickets are \$10 from October 1-15, and they will be \$15 from October 16-23. All tickets must be purchased from Mrs. Sadler.

Students are permitted to bring a non-CHS student as a date if they've completed a permission form. These forms can be picked up from the front counter in the main office or from Mrs. Sadler starting Monday, September 28. A form must be completed before a ticket can be purchased. Students from other schools must be in good standing. Students who have graduated must not have a criminal record and may be no older than 20 years old.

Appropriate dress for the semi-formal Homecoming Dance will include the following guidelines:

- *No jeans, t-shirts, casual, or athletic wear is permitted.
- *Spaghetti straps and strapless dresses ARE permitted.
- *Two-piece dresses must overlap. No midriff can show even when arms are raised.
- *Front and back of dress must not be too low-cut or revealing. Back of dress should not go below natural waist.
- *Short dresses must follow dress code measurement and be no shorter than four inches from the top of the knee. This includes any slits on long dresses.
- *Boys must wear standard semi-formal wear, which includes dark business suits (or dress pants with a dress shirt) and appropriate footwear.
- *No flip-flops, tennis shoes, work boots, or athletic shoes will be allowed.
- *Proper and formal grooming is expected.

Students who are not dressed appropriately, WILL NOT be allowed to enter.

Door Decorating Contest

This year we are bringing back the door decorating contest! Teachers can show Caroline pride by decorating classroom doors to encourage our football team to **'unplug the Chargers!'** This is a great way to encourage students to show their spirit as well.
